COGGO (The Council of Grain Grower Organisations) operates a fund that invests in innovative research and development projects to lift the profitability of Western Australian grain producers.

Projects can target any part of the WA grain supply chain which benefits WA grain growers. Funding for projects is in the range of \$20,000 - \$50,000 per annum over a project life of one or two years, commencing in 2019.
